Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the respondents particularly the 2nd respondent in not considering the petitioner for counseling and admission into MBBS/BDS Course under Management Quota C NRI Category for the Academic year 2024-25 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents to consider and include the name of the petitioner for admission into MBBS/BDS course under Management Quota C NRI category for the Academic year 2024-25 in the counseling.

**IA NO: 1 OF 2024**

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 2nd respondent to consider the petitioner's request under Management Quota

"C" NRI Category for admission into MBBS/BDS course in the counseling for the academic year 2024-25, pending disposal of the writ petition.

**ORDER:** *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Alok Aradhe)*

Mr. L. Ram Singh, learned counsel represents  
Mr. Y. Koteswara Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner.

Mr. G. Ravi, learned counsel represents  
Mr. A. Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing Counsel for  
Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences  
(hereinafter referred to as 'the University') representing  
respondent No.2.

2. With the consent of the parties, the matter is heard  
finally.

3. In this writ petition, the petitioner *inter alia* has  
prayed for the following relief:

"For the reasons stated in the  
accompanying affidavit, it is hereby prayed  
that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to  
issue a writ, order or direction, more

particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the inaction of the respondents particularly the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in not considering the petitioner for counseling and admission into MBBS/BDS course under Management Quota "C" NRI Category for the academic year 2024-25 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents to consider and include the name of the petitioner for admission into MBBS/BDS course under Management Quota "C" NRI Category for the academic year 2024-25 in the counselling and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that even though the petitioner had applied for admission against management quota seats in "B' category, she could not upload for C-Category i.e., NRI category as she could not get sponsor letter and NRI documents. Therefore, she approached respondent No.2 to consider

her request under C-category, but respondent No.2 is not permitting her to seek admission against Management Quota in "C" (NRI) category seats. He further submitted that the petitioner be granted liberty to submit a representation to the University and the University be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

5. Learned Standing Counsel for the University submitted that the last date of registration was 23.08.2024 and thereafter, merit list has been prepared, which shall be published at the time of indicating the web options. However, it is fairly submitted by him that in case the petitioner submits a representation, the same shall be dealt with by the University in accordance with law.

6. In view of the aforesaid submission and in the peculiar facts of the case, the Writ Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to submit a representation before the University with regard to her grievance.

Needless to state that in case such a representation is made, the University shall decide the same within a period of three (03) days thereafter. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
